•	Minimum Continuous Registration Policy: Minimum Continuous Registration Policy: must register for at least one course every Fall and Spring semester until the final oral defense is completed. International students have additional requirements. Apply for a Leave of Absence if you are unable to register in any Fall or Spring semester. https://gradschool.utah.edu/current-students/forms/
•	Residency for Tuition Purposes (Out-of State, domestic students only): You can apply for Utah residency after your first year of study, which means in-state tuition. Apply through the Admissions Office. You will need documentation such as Utah driver's license, etc.
•	Application for Graduation: Complete the form on the Registrar's Office website, http://registrar.utah.edu/ Print it out and sign it. Follow all of the instructions on the form and submit to Registrar's Office (Graduation window).

- Deadlines: June 1 for Fall graduation, November 1 for Spring and February 1 for Summer. There are currently no late fees for grad students, but this may change.

•	Thesis vs Project: Project is preferred by the program. Projects are edited by your committee chair; theses are edited by the Thesis Office. For project, register for minimum 3 credit hours of Research Methods, Econ 6955. http://gradschool.utah.edu/ Please download "Guidelines to Writing a Project/Thesis" on the Masters Program webpage here: http://economics.utah.edu/grad/index.php
•	Final Oral Defense: Should occur in the final semester and you must be registered for at least one course. Arrange date and time with your Supervisory Committee, notify the Academic Advisor.
	Thesis Office (only for Thesis):

- The Thesis Office in the Graduate School will be doing the final editing of your thesis.
- Minimum 6 credit hours of Econ 6970 are required.
- Deadlines and formatting standards are strict, please follow them carefully.
